

Music Teacher Job Specification

Nant-y-Cwm Steiner School is looking for an enthusiastic individual to teach Music lessons on a part-time basis.

The Music Teacher will be part of a Teaching Team working in the main school and will be responsible for planning and delivering the Steiner Waldorf Music curriculum.

Responsible to: The Teaching Team and School Management Team.
The Music Teacher will be supported by an appointed member of the Teaching Team.

Main tasks:

1. To provide a balanced curriculum and maintain progress of all class members in the subject at a pace suitable to their age and development and with regard to the School's curriculum policy.
2. To plan and prepare lessons.
3. To maintain excellent discipline and clear boundaries so that the learning objectives of the class and the provisions of the School's Health and Safety policy are met.
4. To follow the School's Planning, Recording and Assessment Policy.
5. Be aware of and work to the Schools policies and procedures.

Further duties will include:

- Attendance at some parents' evenings
- Monitoring, and keeping, to budget
- Preparation of annual reports for pupils
- Participation in training days when required

The job will entail:

- Keeping the children up to standard with pipe or recorder work, and their musical development, according to their age group and the principles of education laid down by Rudolf Steiner.
- Having an understanding of the Steiner Waldorf curriculum for music.
- Writing individual pupil reports at the end of the academic year.
- Working alongside the Class Teachers.

Terms & conditions:

8 lessons a week, term time only plus statutory holiday pay. Any occasional additional agreed hours helping with music at festivals will be paid at £12.99 per hour.
