

Woodwork Teacher Job Specification

Nant-y-Cwm Steiner School is looking for an enthusiastic individual to teach Woodwork lessons on a part-time basis.

The Woodwork Teacher will be part of a Teaching Team working in the main school and will be responsible for planning and delivering the Steiner Waldorf Woodwork curriculum.

Responsible to: The Teaching Team and School Management Team.
The Woodwork Teacher will be supported by an appointed member of the Teaching Team.

Main tasks

1. To provide an age appropriate curriculum for Woodwork based on an understanding of the Steiner Waldorf curriculum.
2. To plan and prepare and deliver Woodwork lessons.
3. To plan an annual scheme of work: managing and resourcing materials within an agreed budget.
4. To maintain good classroom behaviour to ensure learning objectives of the class and the provisions of the School's Health and Safety policy are met.
5. To record pupils' progress and write an annual report.
6. To liaise with the SENCO and class teacher as appropriate.
7. Be aware of the school's policies, procedures and Health and Safety documents.
8. To attend INSET training days as required.



All staff at Nant-y-Cwm School have a duty to safeguard pupils from physical, sexual, emotional abuse and neglect. This includes reporting any concerns to the CPO. All staff must be familiar with the Safeguarding and Whistle blowing policy.

Staff must take care of the children under their supervision by taking all reasonable steps to ensure their health, safety and welfare, including ensuring first aid is administered when required. Staff must be aware of any Health Care Plan in place for any child under their supervision. All staff have responsibility for their actions within the school grounds and in ensuring the health, safety and welfare of all children, staff, including teaching, support and temporary staff. All staff also have a duty to ensure those pupils, visitors, contractors and others are not put at risk by any activities or the condition of our buildings, site and equipment. Risks should be assessed by the person conducting the activity and managed accordingly.
